Tournament Rules and Regulations

1) 2 Man Referee System

2) Any team official or player who receives a game misconduct, gross misconduct, match penalty or game ejection shall not participate until their case has been dealt with by the discipline committee. Their decision shall be final.

3) All teams will play a minimum of three (3) games. Games will be three periods running time (15) (15) (15). Last 2 minutes of the 3rd will be stop time if the game is within 2 goals. At the start of the game, the clock will be set to 18 minutes. Once the time keeper hits the buzzer to call the teams out, the clock will start shortly after. There will be a flood after every game.

*******Note: If a player is injured the clock will continue to run for 2 minutes. At that point the clock will stop until the injured player leaves the ice surface.**

4) Divisional Format:

4 Team Division: Each team will play 1 game against each other, after round robin the top 2 teams will play against each other in the finals.

Tie Breaker:

i) The record against each other – Head to Head

if still tied,

ii) Add goals for to goals against and divide into goals for, the team with the higher percentage will advance.

if still tied,

iii) Team with the lowest goals against.

if still tied,

iii) The teams tied with lowest goals against and most goals for.

if still tied,

IV) Teams will be drawn from a hat to determine who will advance.

5) Playoff games, if tied at the end of regulation time:

A) Teams will play a 10 minute running time sudden death overtime period of 4 on 4 play. Change on the fly only! The first team to score a goal will be the winner.

B) If the teams remain tied at the end of the first overtime period there will be a 3 player shoot out. If still tied, a sudden death shoot out will be the deciding factor. Players cannot shoot twice before each player has shot once.

6) Each team shall have a suggested minimum of twelve players.

7) All players including goaltenders must wear CSA approved helmets, facemasks and BNQ neck protectors.

8) It is the aim of the tournament to provide an opportunity for the players to participate in a tournament that will increase their skills and promote good sportsmanship.

11) It is expected that coaches, managers, trainers and spectators will not create situations that are in opposition to this aim.

12) ALL entry fees are nonrefundable.

13) The tournament Committee shall decide on any rule(s) in question during this tournament. Their decision shall be final.

14) All teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time.
